



GUIDE TO GRI PRIORITY REPORT

The Priority Report features computer driven technical analysis of important price pattern signals affecting trends and market trading. The Priority Technical System (PTS) developed by our technicians and programmers provides a modular tracking program, generating commentary feedback on developing technical price action with a priority ranking to identify for traders which indicators may critically affect trading strategies. The design of PTS is to compliment human driven technical analysis featured on the Daily Technical Overview by our in house technician, John Helms. The interpretive computer analysis mimics the commentary style of the Overview, but follows pure price pattern studies of technical data. Users will find Priority signals will systematically detail key levels that should be incorporated into trading strategies.

Key Details

- The PTS system provides a rank interpretation that could include opposing signals, one bull and one bear. The reader will need to interpret the merits of either indicator.
- The Priority indicators use some commonly understand signals, but many incorporate proprietary signals developed by GRI. We have selected indicators based on price pattern behavior that provide important signals or should be used as tools within an individuals trading strategy. The PTS does not try to capture the full spectrum of trading signals publicly available with many charting or data services, but rather to highlight important ones to add to your trading program.
- Note that the indicators try to capture the ideals of many patterns. We are trying to identify the most reliable signals from pattern developments. However, given the variability of market behavior, we may see price action that falls outside the “normal” behavior and must be aware that if results seem out-of-line, understand that this means the indicator is being stretched beyond reasonable reliability. An indicator with these kind of results should be disregarded for that day.
- The Priority Report has a preset structure, covering the primary contract as found within the Overview reports for US and European markets. We run Priority signals on all the markets in our data base and additional contracts are available with the Sector or Global Trader reports.
- The Priority Report only features the top ranked signals. Often the PTS will find 4-6 indicators on a given day. An expanded listing of signals are available using the Sector or Global Trader reports.
- The Priority Report is published and distributed each evening between 6:00-9:00 PM CST.
